Street Parking

When snow is expected, street parking is not allowed during and immediately after a snowfall until the roads have been cleared.

Please note that no calls will be made regarding parking violations. Any vehicles in violation may be towed at the owner's expense. For your convenience, additional parking is available at the Community Center.

Sledding

For the safety of all, sleigh riding is not permitted near roadways and sidewalks

Outdoor Faucets and Hoses:

Disconnect and drain any garden hoses from outdoor faucets. If possible, cover outdoor faucets with a towel to protect them from freezing.

Trash & Recycling

We request that trash and recycle cans be pulled in asap if snowing on a pick up day to allow for proper snow removal from the roadway and sidewalks without obstructions

MAINTENANCE UPDATE

Effective 1 January 2025 we will no longer be providing refrigerator water filters. Any residents who have a refrigerator that requires a water filter will have the option to purchase and install their own filter or we can offer a filter bypass option. The water is monitored by the Town Water Department and is tested by the Town. Any one who is interested in a water report can contact the town water quality report at (845) 563-4636.

SAFETY TIPS


We love seeing your holiday lights!

Every year, holiday lights should be tested for safety prior to use. If you choose to purchase new lights this year, look for a label indicating that the lights were independently tested for safety. Whether they are new or old, inspect each set of lights for broken or cracked sockets, frayed or bare wires, or loose connections. As a reminder: For your safety, please remember that placing lights on the second story or roof of your home is not allowed.
